APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be admitted into the program (Diploma / Certificate / Postgraduate / Degree) of choice, the following conditions apply:

- Applicant has completed BC secondary school graduation in any program, or the equivalent in another school system; OR
- Applicant has completed all but one required course for BC secondary school graduation in any program, or the equivalent in another school system; OR
- Applicant will be at least 19 years of age by the end of the first month of the first semester of attendance; OR
- Applicant will be at least 17 years of age on the first day of the first semester of attendance and has not been enrolled at a school for at least one year; OR
- If applicant is a special needs student, applicant has completed a certificate or equivalent from a special program, and has been in school for 12 years.

Application Package Checklist:

1. Apply to Douglas College online:

2. Submit high school transcripts if applying more than six months after graduating from High School.
3. If the student has attended other post-secondary institutions they will need to provide Douglas College with Official Transcript(s).
4. If the student is planning to use some of the courses taken at a post-secondary institution to meet prerequisite requirements at Douglas College please be sure to complete a Transfer of Credit form, available from the Registrar's Office.
5. Apply early for sponsorship from a brand or agency. Most bands and agencies require 3 or more month's notice prior to registration and fee payment date. These dates are not the same as the day classes begin.
6. If the student requires an Assessment Test please go to the website for information on the tests, dates and times that they will take place.

TRANSFER STATISTICS

Douglas College gives students the opportunity to transfer to a different university or college after two years. The college has transfer agreements with universities in Canada, the US, UK, Europe, Asia, Australia and Latin America. This gives students access to over 1000 courses.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

For students starting in September: 1 May

For students starting in January: 1 November

For students starting in May: 1 March

All programs have an application deadline date. Candidates will be selected for admission on a first-qualified, first-admitted basis, except where a program has established an admission process that first ranks each candidate within the pool of qualified candidates, then selects candidates based on their rank order (highest to lowest). Date of qualification is used if rankings are tied. Some programs offer early admission - refer to the program description section for details.

Electronic submissions are accepted.
